Here is a schedule for viewing priority of Laura's performance along with some notes from Laura (see below).

From Laura: I will perform masked, as per COVID-19 protocols. It's not to be 'read' as part of the work but it is absolutely necessary. As attendees you will also be masked. As I walk across the room you can feel welcome to be behind me, in front, beside etc while maintaining 2 metres of separation. This is probably what you would be doing anyway.

There is a beginning, middle and end but if you need to step in and out you should feel welcome. In a similar manner, if yourself uncomfortable (due to spacing, images, content), I expect you will take care of yourself as needed.

While structured, this is not theatre. Nor is it interactive or collaborative. If I require assistance you will know, and you can choose not to engage.

With apologies to our classmates who cannot attend, due to distance or systemic barriers that render our building inaccessible. I will take some images and I may experiment with youtube streaming. Only so much will be readable from the documentation. That's one of the strengths and limitations of working like this.
